

# Did you know...?

## *Fundraising opportunities through the end of the summer!*

- **Dine Out Night - Tuesday, May 24 at Lone Star Steakhouse**
  - 61st and E. Hillside Dr. (next to Bass Pro), 11am-10pm
  - Dine in or drive through
  - 15% of proceeds from full-priced items go to the Pride
  - MUST PRESENT A FLYER TO THE SERVER PRIOR TO ORDERING! (Flyer can be found on Broken Arrow Bands Facebook page.)
- **Discount Cards**
  - Sell May 9-June 30.
  - Maximum number of cards checked out at one time is 15.
  - Additional cards can be checked out if you would like more to sell.
  - Student accounts will be charged \$5 per card for each card that has either not been turned had money turned in for on the card not turned back in at the end of the selling period.
  - Profit margin on these cards is \$15 per card to the student's account.
- **Ma & Pa Kettle Corn**
  - Pre-sell from July 1-12.
  - All order forms and money collected is due in the band office on Tuesday, July 12.
  - Profit to student account is 50%.
- **Rustic Cuff**
  - Pre-sell during August.
  - Three new styles to choose from.
  - Profit to student account is \$10 per bracelet (\*student must have sold 10 bracelets total for the general fund between the first Rustic Cuff fundraiser last March and this one before anything is credited to the student account).
- **Fun Pasta**
  - Pre-sell during August.
  - All natural dry pasta with personality! Also, soup mixes, cookie mixes, and some cookies.
  - All order forms and money collected is due in the band office on Thursday, August 27.
  - Profit to student account is 40%.
- **Donate to the Pride**
  - Ask friends and family to sponsor your student.
  - Have them fill out a special form, and send it to the band office with along with their check.
  - Profit to student account is 100%\* (\*minus \$15 for a sponsor hat).
- **Worlds Finest Chocolate**
  - Each case cost \$30. You sell each chocolate bar for \$1 and almond bar for \$2.
  - The profit you make from selling is turned in to the band office directly as a band account payment.
  - In August, this will change to a new policy. You will pay for cost and profit both upfront, so each case will cost \$60, and your profit will be credited to your student account; you will then sell the chocolate and almond bars as you can and keep the money to reimburse yourself.
- **External Fundraising Work Events**
  - Send an email to BAPridework@hotmail.com to receive emails regarding upcoming work opportunities.
  - You can sign up for work once you receive an email requesting people for a particular event. (Spots fill up quickly so reply as soon as you are certain you can work.)
  - A food handler's permit is required for the work we do. You can obtain the permit free and online at <http://www.tulsa-health.org/food-safety/food-classes-permits/volunteer-classes> or you can go to the Health Department
  - Drillers Baseball - current games plus the possibility of playoff games.
  - Tulsa Roughnecks Soccer – current season games.
  - Expo - We will need lots of workers for the Tulsa State Fair. (We've had families plan vacation time during the fair so that they could work many, if not all of the days, and fund their whole Pride account.) Other Expo opportunities will come up throughout the year such as Boat Shows, Car Shows, Gun Shows, etc.
  - There are a few other fundraising opportunities that come up from companies that use us once or twice a year. Email notices will be sent out about these just the same as any other event.

**October** - live wreaths and mini trees - profit to student account is \$10 per item.

**November** - One Up Pro name rings - profit to student account is 40%.
