# Winter Conference COVID-19 Policies

OkMEA is excited to host our All-State Festival this year. OkMEA is actively monitoring health and safety guidelines and recommendations at the federal, state, and local level. As new best practices become available, we may update our policies and procedures regarding COVID-19 in relation to the OkMEA 2022 Winter Conference. Below you will find our COVID-19 policies (as of October 14, 2021) for the All-State festival. Please note that the policies have been updated as of November 12, 2021. Changes are in blue below and pertain to the Children's Chorus only.

# **Children's All-State Students**

OkMEA will **require** the following of all Children's students:

- 1. All-State students will be **required** to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth during rehearsals, rehearsal snack breaks (unless actively eating or drinking), and the concert.
  - a. If you are observing a Children's Chorus rehearsal as a teacher or chaperone, you will be **required** to wear a mask.
  - b. If you are assisting during a rehearsal snack break as a teacher or chaperone, you will be **required** to wear a mask.
- 2. Students will be spaced three feet apart during rehearsals at the Cox Business Center.

  OkMEA will work with the conference venue to provide social distancing during the concert.
- 3. Frequent hand washing and sanitizing is highly recommended.
- 4. Individuals should monitor their health closely and should stay home if experiencing COVID-related symptoms.
  - a. If the student becomes ill on site, the student will be expected to leave the festival. The student will not be penalized and will receive All-State patch and certificate.

## **HS All-State Students**

OkMEA will encourage the following of all Children's and HS All-State students:

- 1. All-State students will be encouraged to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth while indoors and while riding OkMEA shuttle transportation. Students will be required to wear masks if dictated by the conference venue.
  - a. Indoors includes the Cox Business Center, all hotels, and all rehearsal/performance venues.
  - b. During rehearsal, masks will be encouraged unless the student is actively playing a wind instrument (woodwind or brass).

- c. Exception: The Tulsa Performing Arts Center (TPAC) requires masks therefore all All-State students will be required to wear masks while indoors at the TPAC.
- 2. Social distancing will be highly recommended, and OkMEA will work with the conference venue to provide spacious seating in all rehearsals when possible.
- 3. Frequent hand washing and sanitizing is highly recommended.
- 4. Individuals should monitor their health closely and should stay home if experiencing COVID-related symptoms.
  - a. If the student becomes ill on site, the student will be expected to leave the festival. The student will not be penalized and will receive All-State patch and certificate.

## **Concert Patrons**

OkMEA will encourage the following of patrons attending Honor Group concerts and/or All-State performances:

- 1. Patrons will be encouraged to wear a mask that covers the nose and mouth while indoors. Patrons will be required to wear masks if dictated by the conference venue.
  - a. Indoors includes the Cox Business Center, all hotels, and all performance venues.
  - b. Exception: The Tulsa Performing Arts Center (TPAC) requires masks therefore all patrons will be required to wear masks while indoors at the TPAC.
- 2. Social distancing will be highly recommended, and OkMEA will work with the conference venue to provide spacious seating in all session spaces when possible.
- 3. Frequent hand washing and sanitizing is highly recommended.
- 4. Individuals should monitor their health closely and should stay home if experiencing COVID-related symptoms.

# **Refund Policy**

All registration fees are non-refundable for the conference and All-State festivals.

# **Participation Disclaimer**

By registering my student for this event, I acknowledge that I fully understand the nature and extent of the risks presented by COVID-19 due to my in-person attendance at this event, including the risk that COVID-19 may lead to severe illness or death. I also understand and acknowledge that there are risks of exposure to COVID-19, whether resulting from travel through high risk areas, the failure of other individuals to follow proper COVID-19 protocols, such as maintaining proper social distancing and proper hygiene measures, and other such risks. While I understand that OkMEA has taken

reasonable steps to address the risks presented by COVID-19, I recognize that the COVID-19 protocols being utilized at the event may be insufficient to prevent my student from contracting COVID-19 and suffering any related injuries, and that I expressly nevertheless assume all of these risks.

With full knowledge of the risks involved, therefore, I hereby release, waive, and discharge OkMEA, its officers, directors, employees, contractors, and agents, from any and all liability, loss, damage, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, including reasonable attorneys' fees, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, injury, or death, that may be sustained by me while participating in this event or while in, on, or around the event premises that may lead to exposure or harm due to COVID-19.

# **OkMEA HS All-State Student Code of Conduct**

- Students will prepare all assigned music prior to arriving.
  - Note: HS Chorus students will participate in a third round of auditions before rehearsals begin on Thursday morning.
- Students must bring their instrument, accessories (including mutes), music stand, All-State music, and a pencil to all rehearsals.
  - Note: OkMEA will provide various large percussion instruments.
- All students must be prompt and *attend all rehearsals and all concerts in their entirety*.
  - o Tardiness will not be permitted. Students arriving late to rehearsals will be dismissed.
  - Note: It is the responsibility of the student to plan ahead to make sure there are no obligations that would require the student to miss any part of rehearsals or the concert.
  - Exception: If the student's school is an OkMEA Honor Group and their group is scheduled for a soundcheck or performance during rehearsal, they are excused from rehearsal.
- Students are to immediately report any accidents, injuries, and/or illnesses to the ensemble chair.
- As representatives of their school, students will uphold the highest standards of conduct. Students will cooperate fully with conductors, co-chairs, directors, and any other OkMEA officials.
- Use of cell phones, tablets, laptops, or other electronic devices by students during rehearsals and performances is prohibited, unless authorized by the chair or conductor.
- Pranks or vandalism of any kind will not be tolerated. Students and their parents/legal guardians will assume full financial responsibility for any damage caused by the Student.
- Use, possession, or acquisition of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, or illegal drugs is prohibited at any time during participation. Any violation of this rule will be reported to the school director and result in immediate dismissal.
- Students must dress appropriately (following their school's dress code), and the official OkMEA identification badge must worn by the student and be visible at all times.
- In regards to the hotel:
  - Students must remain reasonable quiet at all time in the hotel rooms, both day and night.
  - Electronic devices must be played at low levels at all times.
  - Hotel doors should remain locked at all times.
  - Boys are not allowed in the girls' rooms and girls are not allowed in the boys' rooms. If it is necessary to make an exception, a chaperone must be present.
  - Curfew for students will be 11:00pm on Thursday evening and 12:00am (midnight) on Friday evening of the festival. Students are not allowed to leave their room after curfew.
- In regards to health:
  - Students who become ill during the course of the festival will be asked to leave.
  - If a student is asked to leave due to illness, the student will still receive their participation patch, certificate and medal (if applicable).

We understand that OkMEA has sole discretion to make all decisions including, but not limited to, decisions regarding disciplinary matters and the final approval of students selected to perform. It is expressly understood by students, parents/legal guardians, and their respective program directors that any infraction of the above rules on attendance and/or for conduct unbecoming for an All-State musician may constitute grounds for dismissal from All-State activities.
