Broken Arrow Bands and Football Booster Club 50/50 Raffle Rules

The Broken Arrow Band Booster Club, Inc. (BABBC), operates as a non-profit organization under the laws of the State of Oklahoma for the primary purpose of supporting band related educational activities of the Broken Arrow Public Schools (BAPS) in Broken Arrow, OK. The Broken Arrow Football Booster Club (BAFBC) operates as a non-profit organization under the laws of the State of Oklahoma for the primary purpose of supporting football related physical and educational activities of the Broken Arrow Public Schools (BAPS) in Broken Arrow, OK. The 2022 BABBC and BAFBC 50/50 Raffle is conducted for the purpose of generating funds to offset band and football financial obligations.

1. ELIGIBILITY. Each entrant, by entering the Raffle, agrees to abide by all of the rules and conditions contained herein, as well as all applicable local, state and federal laws and regulations, and further agrees to release BABBC and BAFBC and its directors, officers, volunteers, members and employees from any and all liability with respect to all aspects of the raffle including, but not limited to, the selection process and all activities associated with the prizes awarded. The Raffle is open to any eligible person residing in a state, county or city where the Raffle is not prohibited. Executive Officers of the BABBC and BAFBC Board of Directors, BABBC and BAFBC Fundraising Executive Committee members or associated Booster Club members selling raffle tickets, BAPS Athletic Directors, BAPS Football Coaches and football staff, BAPS Band Directors and the immediate family members of all aforementioned persons and prize suppliers and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in the Raffle. Immediate family members are described as spouse, children, or any extended family living in the same household. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older, of legal competence and a legal resident of the United States of America.

2. TICKET DISTRIBUTION. A single, numbered ticket with a corresponding tear off stub for the Raffle shall be issued in conjunction with each \$5 donation as a suggested voluntary contribution made to BABBC and BAFBC for the purpose of generating funds to offset band and football financial obligations. There is no set limit on the amount of 50/50 tickets to be distributed, and will be available until the established set time or until no tickets remain or whichever comes first. An entrant can enter the Raffle and obtain a Ticket by making donations at the event, directly to Board members of the BABBC or BAFBC or their representatives, where Tickets are made available. Donations can be made with cash only. The 50/50 Raffle Ticket sales will be available the day of the event when the Tiger Memorial Stadium spectator gates open for participants until the beginning of the third quarter of the same event or such time as the total designated number of Raffle tickets have been issued, whichever comes first. All Raffles tickets will be issued on a first served basis. Winner must have the original Raffle Ticket matching the corresponding stub drawn in order to receive the Prize. Failure to produce the original Raffle Ticket within ten (10) standard clock minutes of Raffle Winning Ticket number announcement will result in forfeiture of the Grand Prize and an alternate winner will be drawn. Raffle Tickets have no cash or redemption value. The voluntary contribution associated with the Raffle Ticket is not tax deductible.

3. BABBC AND BAFBC BENEFITS OF RAFFLE TICKET. Donations qualifying for a Raffle Ticket are for the sole purpose of band or football related financial obligations including, but not limited to show expenses, student uniforms/equipment, training, camps, and band/football travel.

4. GRAND PRIZE. The Grand Prize is valued based on a Fifty Percent (50%) split of the net proceeds (income less expenses) equally between the Grand Prize winner and BABBC/BAFBC organizations.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF GRAND PRIZE WINNER

The Winner will be required to provide BABBC and BAFBC with a valid form of government issued photo identification and U.S.A. social security number and must complete all IRS and similar forms requested by BABBC and BAFBC prior to delivery of their prize. Failure to do so within 10 minutes of request shall result in an automatic forfeiture of such winner's prize.

Prizes over \$600 must be reported to the IRS.

Should the Prize be over \$5000 (Prize minus the ticket cost) the regular gambling withholding for the IRS applies and BABBC and BAFBC will withhold 25% from the winnings and report this amount to the IRS on Form W-2G. Winner must complete and sign a W-2G form and all required tax forms, verify his/her social security number and 25% of the cash winning proceeds will be withheld for the federal income tax withholding requirement by BABBC/BAFBC prior to release of the 50/50 Grand Prize cash proceeds. Winner is responsible for any backup withholding required by the IRS. BABBC/BAFBC will submit the taxes collected to the IRS on behalf of the Winner. BABBC/BAFBC will file a form W-2G with the IRS to report the value of the prize won and the taxes paid by the Winner. Winner will receive a copy of the W-2G. Winner should consult a tax professional.

6. WINNING CHANCES. Winning chances are subject to the amount of Raffle Tickets issued. There is no set quantity of Raffle Tickets sold and Raffle Tickets are only subject to the amount of Raffle Tickets issued within the designated sale period or if Raffle Tickets sell out whichever comes first. Each Raffle Ticket represents one chance to win the Grand Prize.

7. DRAWING. The Grand Prize Winner will be determined by a random drawing of the corresponding Raffle Ticket stubs of all the eligible Raffle Tickets issued by the entry deadline. The Grand Prize drawing will be held at Broken Arrow High School Tiger Memorial Stadium toward the end of the third quarter and will be supervised by members of the BABBC Board of Directors and/or BAFBC Board of Directors. All eligible Raffle

Tickets issued by the date and time for the drawing as noted above will be eligible for the Grand Prize drawing. Alternate Winner names will be drawn, and such persons will be contacted by BABBC/BAFBC in the event that the original prize winners are deemed ineligible. Winners must be present to win and must claim the Grand Prize within ten (10) standard clock minutes of public announcement of winning Raffle Ticket number otherwise the next eligible alternate Winner will be announced.

8. MODIFICATION OR CANCELLATION OF DRAWING. BABBC/BAFBC reserves the right to cancel or modify the Raffle at any time. If all available Raffle Tickets are distributed before the scheduled Grand Prize drawing time (i.e., BABBC and/or BAFBC has determined that the raffle is "sold out"), BABBC/BAFBC reserves the right to end the raffle early by holding the Grand Prize Drawing at an earlier time than the scheduled publicized drawing time.

9. WINNER. The winning Raffle Ticket number will be announced by a BABBC or BAFBC representative during the fourth quarter of the football event at Tiger Memorial Stadium either by public announcement on the field, over the stadium sound system, and/or via an announcement on the electronic scoreboard. Name of Winner will be available to all media and will be available at the offices of Broken Arrow Fine Arts Department. Winning entrant agrees to allow BABBC/BAFBC to use their name, likeness, and any statements made by him/her regarding the prize for advertising or publicity purposes without compensation. Winner may be required to complete and return an affidavit of eligibility and liability release. Failure to do so if requested, or if Winner otherwise fails to comply with these rules and/or to make arrangements to claim his/her prize within ten (10) standard clock minutes of announcement will void that entry and thus forfeit the prize.

10. AWARDING OF GRAND PRIZE. Only one person will be deemed an entrant per Raffle Ticket issued and only one person shall be deemed the Grand Prize Winner. A valid government issued photo identification and U.S.A. social security number must be provided by the Grand Prize Winner, and it must be that of the entrant. Delivery or payment of the prize shall be made solely to the entrant. In a multiple party entry, it is the sole responsibility of the entrant to allocate any such prize among the participants in a multiple party entry.

11. AUTHORITY AND CONTROL. The decision of BABBC and BAFBC shall be final in all matters concerning the Raffle. The Raffle is subject to the laws of the State of Oklahoma. Void where prohibited by law. BABBC and BAFBC reserve the right to amend, modify or otherwise alter these rules at any time.

12. OVERSIGHT. The 2022 Broken Arrow Band and Broken Arrow Football Booster Clubs 50/50 Raffle is overseen by the Broken Arrow Band Booster Club, Inc., in Broken Arrow, OK and the Broken Arrow Football Booster Club, Inc., in Broken Arrow, OK.
